The Town of Haverstraw sought to increase its public outreach efforts through the use of printed material targeted towards residents, developers and industry, as well as through web site publications.

The Town of Haverstraw developed and disseminated over 4,800 brochures to their target audiences focused on erosion and sediment control and waste control. Information was distributed at four locations to maximize effectiveness. The Town actively partnered with the Cornell Cooperative Extension and the Stormwater Consortium of Rockland County. The Town participated in County-wide workshops focused on water quality and maintained a stormwater web site.
