PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

<u>Favio Ortega, Pratt Street, Haverstraw</u> expressed his concern for the affect that gangs and drugs have taken over in the Village of Haverstraw. Mr. Ortega owns a family business on 19 New Main Street in the middle of Haverstraw and he is concerned with the gangs in the Village of Haverstraw. Mr. Ortega lives on Pratt Street, he and his neighbors control Pratt Street. We do not depend on the Police Department. The police come with their lights on and the drug dealers split. They sell crack and drugs right behind Hershey's. Everyone knows about this and nothing is done. The Police Department is laughed at.

Mr. Ortega stated that whenever he goes to the Police Station the officer at the front desk dose not even try to get Chief Miller. They would always say that he was in a meeting. Mr. Ortega stated that he had to contact the New York State Police Drug Task Force and told them all of the car license plates and when the drug deals were going on.

Supervisor Phillips stated that the Village of Haverstraw is receiving 75 to 85 % of the Town of Haverstraw Police Departments attention. The Village is too dense in the downtown area and there are too many apartments. The Village of Haverstraw dissolved their Police Department because they couldn't afford it any longer. Since the Town took over, the arrests have doubled in the Village. The Town has implemented a two-two-man street crime unit, has worked with the D.A. and Task Force and we have 5 officers assigned to the REACT Unit and also work with the State Police.

Mr. Ortega suggested to video tape the drug dealers and identify the gangs. Motorcycles and taxies are how they move the drugs and they are moving them right in front of the police.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that the Village of Haverstraw currently does have video and we would be more than willing to put more police officers on the streets in the Village. The Supervisor would like to propose to Mayor Kohut to put two dedicated officers on the streets (Wednesdays through Sundays). We would have to hire three officers – three first grade officers to walk the streets. This is my proposal to the Mayor. The Village must reimburse the Town for a dedicated service. The officers need to be visible during those times. Supervisor further stated that the residents in the unincorporated area never see officers because the Village eats up all of their time. The police make up 65% of our budget and your Town taxes are less than the Village taxes.

<u>Councilman Cancel</u> stated that there was a meeting open to the public on Wednesday, July 1st at 6:00 pm at the Knights of Columbus regarding Block Intervention with the District Attorney's Office.

Supervisor Phillips stated that he is looking forward to seeing Mr. Ortega at the meeting on June 30^{th} at the Knights of Columbus.
