<u>Barry Berman, 19 Turner Drive, Garnerville</u> asked if the Town Board members would ever consider solar panels on streetlights or government buildings in the Town.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that he thought solar power was a good idea and that a couple of years ago, the Town looked into it but it was thought that not enough energy could remain on the wattage that was needed to achieve a sufficient amount so the street lights would operate with sufficient power. Maybe the technology has advanced since then and Pat Brady can take a look at it.

<u>Barry Berman, 19 Turner Drive, Garnerville</u> also suggested having a police officer directing traffic on the streets when United Water, Verizon or Orange & Rockland are doing work. This is a serious problem with traffic and safety issues. These contractors should hire off duty cops or professionals to direct the traffic.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that he agreed with Mr. Berman that the contractors should have a flag person out there when construction is going on. Supervisor stated that he did not think it was necessary to have off duty police officers directing traffic. Every municipality should have something on the books that it is a public safety issue. Let us check and see what the other Villages are doing.

<u>Barry Berman, 19 Turner Drive, Garnerville</u> commended the Town of Haverstraw Police Dept. on a recent situation that arose where he needed to call the police. The two officers acted very professionally and things went very smoothly. It worked out really nice.

<u>Ilan Schulein, Hillside Drive, Thiells</u> stated to the Board that he was concerned about the stop line on Mountainview Road not being close enough to Rosman Road.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> thanked Mr. Schulein for bringing the matter to their attention.

St. Peter's held their Annual Parish Picnic at Bowline yesterday.
