PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Supervisor Phillips stated that we have been adopting the tax rate in a meeting during the day for as long as he has been an employee in the Town of Haverstraw. He wanted to correct erroneous information that Ms. Teger has put out on websites that the Town did not give notice. We did. Quite frankly, you should apologize to the entire board because you keep putting out false information. We gave notice to the Journal News, which is the legal newspaper in the Town of Haverstraw, which we are required to do. This is a pro forma resolution.

Lynn Teger, 5 Simenovsky Drive, Haverstraw stated that having the meeting at 10:00 in the morning and people getting notice of it the day before does not give people an opportunity to attend if they would like to attend. She would like to see the Town in compliance with the New York State Open Meetings law. That was the only issue she addressed on the posting.

Supervisor Phillips stated that we had it to the media in the proper time before we had this meeting but your posting insinuates that we were doing something nefarious and clandestine when we haven't. The tax rates are determined by the budgets that are adopted by the Town and by other agencies such as Rockland County Solid Waste and fire departments. We passed our budget in November and we could not establish our tax rates until the county's budget was approved. There are some 20 plus different rates that must be calculated. When everything is checked by the Director of Finance we hold a meeting as soon as possible because it must be given to the assessor, receiver of taxes and the company that produces the tax bills so they can be completed by the end of the year and out to the residents by Tuesday, January 3, 2012. It's simple math. Some towns adopt the tax rate at their Town Board meeting but we try to do it before. We have been doing it this way since Phillip Rotella was supervisor and before then when Shankey was supervisor 34 years ago.
