PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Noel Rappaport, 7 Lewis Drive, Garnerville wanted to know why Channel 12 News and the Journal News never separate the news when something happens in the Villages of West Haverstraw and Haverstraw – they never separate the dirty news it's always the Town of Haverstraw. Mr. Rappaport also asked if there was a sign ordinance in the Town because the Subway sign at the Rosman Shopping Center is not uniform with the other signs.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that we will take a look if we adopted a new sign ordinance. It should have gone before the Architectural Review Board and I'm wondering if they came before them.

Noel Rappaport, 7 Lewis Drive, Garnerville stated that the Town is doing a great job of snow removal.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that we appreciate that and that Noel Rappaport owns a business in the Town of Haverstraw. Over the years he has always contributed to charitable events that we have hosted and has been a member of the Haverstraw Ambulance Corp for more than 30 years.

BOARD MEMBERS

<u>Councilman Cancel</u> stated that someone already praised the snow removal. You can see the difference between our neighboring towns. Someone told him that when you get to Haverstraw you can really see the difference.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that we have a great reputation for snow removal. The Highway Department does a great job keeping the roads clear.

As we are getting into the New Year, there are a number of capital projects such as the Bowline Pump Station, which will be approximately \$190,000 and will be funded through grants. We are also purchasing two new dump trucks and new road resurfacing. Several trips have been planned by the Youth Board for February and March.

A parade was held last week for the North Rockland Midget Football Cheerleaders for capturing first place national champions and third place in the nation.

<u>Councilman Cancel</u> stated that he would like to say what a great job everybody did during the house explosion down at Fairgrounds II in West Haverstraw. There was a tremendous coordination with emergency responders.

<u>Supervisor Phillips</u> stated that we organized a Fairgrounds II Disaster Fund and sent out press releases to advise the public. A midnight bowling fundraiser is planned for Friday, February 17 at Hi Tor Bowling. Kenny Patterson, who was one of the firemen injured in the explosion is said to be doing well and was recently transferred to Helen Hayes Hospital. The other fireman, Jerry Knapp, who was also injured is reported to be doing well and is back at home.

The Stony Point Seals will be hosting their Annual Polar Plunge fundraiser into the Hudson River on Super Bowl Sunday, February 5, 2012 at the Grassy Point wall.
