PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

<u>Ilan Schulein, Hillside Drive, Thiells</u> asked the Town Board if something can be done with noise made by the blowers that the landscaper services use when mowing the lawns. The noise is very loud. There are always a few people rushing at the same time running the blowers. The noise penetrates inside. A law should be passed to limit the hours from 8 am to 5 pm on weekdays only. Mr. Shulein stated that he would really appreciate it if an ordinance can be passed to enforce this.

Supervisor Phillips stated that we will look into it and get back to you.

<u>Gil Musinger, 1416 Roundpointe Drive, Haverstraw, NY</u> asked if any consideration has been given to consolidating the police forces into a County force.

Supervisor Phillips stated that you articulated the need for a County police force very well. The Town Board and I have been waiting for years to create a County-wide Police Department. It would be more effective and efficient for the people of the County of Rockland. Certain communities do not want a County-wide Police Department. The unfortunate thing is that right now I don't believe any resident, based upon the County's recent experience dealing with a \$95 million deficit would be willing to give any type of new services to the County.

Mel Post, 1422 Roundpointe Drive, Haverstraw, NY congratulated the Supervisor and the Town on the audit. Perhaps you should take over the County – you would be much more responsible.

Mr. Post also stated that south of the Haverstraw Harbors, where he resides, is Tilcon. He wanted to know if anything could be done with the dust situation. They have not been watering the dust piles and it is all over everything.

Supervisor Phillips stated that he will talk with the president of Tilcon.

<u>Councilman Cancel</u> asked if there was some kind of agreement about a berm and trees that would hold back the dust.

Mel Post, 1422 Roundpointe Drive, Haverstraw, NY stated that Ginsburg bought the trees and that he did not know what agreement they had and would like the Supervisor to talk with him.

Supervisor Phillips stated that he will call them.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Today we celebrated 90+ Recognition Day for the senior citizens who are over 90 years of age at the Knights of Columbus. We had a very festive celebration and wonderful turnout. There are approximately 25 residents in the Town who are over the age of 90 and five residents over the age of 100. The seniors who were honored were served lunch and presented with a gift.

The Town of Haverstraw fireworks are scheduled for Tuesday, July 3rd and the rain date is Wednesday, July 4th at Bowline Park. The Heartbeat Band which is a 10 piece band will be performing the night of the fireworks.

The Thursday Night Open-Air Concerts will begin the first Thursday night after the fireworks at Bowline Park. The concerts will end on Labor Day.

The Latin Parade and Festival will be held on Saturday, July 15th beginning at 12:00 noon. Rain date is Saturday, July 22, 2012. The parade begins at Emeline Park in the Village of Haverstraw and ends up at Haverstraw Middle School.

The swimming pool at Bowline Park was recently resurfaced and new lighting will be installed at the park in the near future.
