RESOLUTION TO ADOPT NEGATIVE DECLARATION REGARDING THE CONVEYANCE OF THE HELEN HAYES BALL FIELDS BY THE STATE OF NEW YORK TO THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW

The following resolution was approved by the full Town Board.

116-14 WHEREAS, THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW APPLIED TO THE STATE OF NEW YORK OFFICE OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR TRANSFER AND CONVEYANCE OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF STATE LAND KNOWN AS THE HELEN HAYES BALL FIELDS, BEING APPROXIMATELY A 25 ACRE PORTION OF THE HELEN HAYES HOSPITAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF WEST HAVERSTRAW, TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW, COUNTY OF ROCKLAND, AND

WHEREAS, AS A CONDITION OF THE CONVEYANCE THE STATE OF NEW YORK HAS REQUESTED THAT THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION AS TO THE ACTION OF THE CONVEYANCE OF THE HELEN HAYES BALL FIELDS, AND

WHEREAS, THE TOWN HAS REQUESTED AND RECEIVED FROM ITS PLANNING CONSULTANT, MICHAEL D. KAUKER, A SHORT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FORM CONTAINING A NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED ACTION, WHICH SPECIFICALLY INCLUDES ACQUISITION OF THE APPROXIMATE 25 ACRE PARCEL, AND

WHEREAS, MICHAEL D. KAUKER HAS PREPARED A NEGATIVE DECLARATION WITH A NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE WHICH IS BASED UPON THE FACT THAT THE ONLY ACTION AT THIS TIME IS LIMITED TO THE ACQUISITION OF THE PROPERTY BY THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW AND THERE IS NO PHYSICAL DISTURBANCE PROPOSED TO THE PROPERTY, AND

WHEREAS, THE LETTERS OF PATENT CONVEYING THE PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW WILL CONTAIN A SPECIFIC CONDITION THAT THE PARCEL WILL BE USED CONTINUOUSLY FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND RECREATION AND IF NOT SO USED, THERE WILL BE A RITE OF REVERTER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE PROPERTY BACK TO THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, THAT THE TOWN BOARD DECLARES ITSELF LEAD AGENCY FOR PURPOSES OF COMPLETING THE REVIEW UNDER THE SEQRA LAW, AND

THE TOWN HEREBY FINDS THAT THE ACTION OF ACQUIRING THE HELEN HAYES BALL FIELDS IS AN UNLISTED ACTION AND DOES NOT HAVE ANY ENVIRONMENTAL SIGNIFICANCE.

THE TOWN HEREBY ADOPTS THE ANNEXED NEGATIVE DECLARATION UNDER THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT AND IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN ACCEPTS AND APPROVES CONVEYANCE OF THE HELEN HAYES BALL FIELDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN THE LETTERS PATENT FROM THE STATE OF NEW YORK.
