The following resolution was offered and unanimously adopted by all of the Town Board Members.

178-15 WHEREAS, THE HAVERSTRAW TOWN BOARD WISHES TO EXPRESS ITS CONTINUING CONDOLENCES TO, AND SUPPORT FOR, THE FAMILY OF PAULA BOHOVESKY, WHO WAS BRUTALLY RAPED AND

MURDERED THIRTY FIVE YEARS AGO, AS PAULA'S FAMILY ASKS THE NEW YORK STATE PAROLE BOARD NOT TO RELEASE HER KILLERS: AND

WHEREAS, IN 1980, PAULA BOHOVESKY WAS A TALENTED ARTIST, AN ASPIRING ACTRESS AND A WELL-REGARDED MEMBER OF THE JUNIOR CLASS AT PEARL RIVER HIGH SCHOOL; AND

WHEREAS, THIS YOUNG WOMAN, BURGEONING WITH ENERGY AND A ZEST FOR LIFE, WAS TRAGICALLY AND SENSELESSLY MURDERED JUST TWO BLOCKS FROM HER HOME; AND

WHEREAS, THE TWO YOUNG MEN WHO COMMITTED THIS HEINOUS CRIME AFTER A DAY SPENT DRINKING IN A LOCAL BAR RECEIVED THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR MURDER THAN ALLOWED IN NEW YORK STATE, TWENTY-FIVE YEARS TO LIFE IN PRISON; AND

WHEREAS, PAULA'S FAMILY AND FRIENDS, AS WELL AS THOSE LIVING IN ROCKLAND COUNTY AT THE TIME, CAN STILL RECALL THE HORROR OF THAT DAY; AND

WHEREAS, PAULA'S MOTHER, LOIS BOHOVESKY, MUST AGAIN RELIVE THAT DAY AS SHE FIGHTS TO KEEP PAULA'S KILLERS IN JAIL BY ASKING THE PAROLE BOARD NOT TO AUTHORIZE THE MEN'S RELEASE, A TASK THAT SHE WILL HAVE TO OFTEN UNDERTAKE BECAUSE STATE LAW ALLOWS INMATES SEEKING PAROLE TO REAPPLY EVERY TWO YEARS; AND

WHEREAS, THE MURDERERS OF PAULA BOHOVESKY ARE AGAIN ELIGIBLE FOR PAROLE AND ARE SEEKING RELEASE FROM PRISON; AND

WHEREAS, THE HAVERSTRAW TOWN BOARD HAS MET, CONSIDERED AND BY A UNANIMOUS VOTE APPROVED THIS RESOLUTION; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, THAT THE TOWN BOARD WISHES TO EXPRESS ITS CONTINUING CONDOLENCES TO, AND SUPPORT FOR THE FAMILY OF PAULA BOHOVESKY, WHO WAS BRUTALLY RAPED AND MURDERED THIRTY FIVE YEARS AGO, AS PAULA'S FAMILY ASKS THE NEW YORK STATE PAROLE BOARD NOT TO RELEASE HER KILLERS.

### **TOWN BOARD MEMBERS**

<u>Supervisor Howard T. Phillips, Jr.</u> asked the department heads for updates on what they are doing in each department.

<u>Cal Fowx, Golf Course Superintendent</u>, stated that the Golf Course is open and that they are installing a new Tee box and it is coming along well.

Michael Cortier, Director of Parks, said that they are doing some work at the police station, cleaning up at the golf course and park's facilities. He also mentioned that they are starting new projects this spring.

<u>Supervisor Howard T. Phillips, Jr.</u> said that the D.E.C stated that we will not be able to start the pier until the fall because of the sturgeon spawning season.

TOWN BOARD GARNERVILLE, NY APRIL 13, 2015

George Wargo, Superintendent of Highways, stated that the roads are in pretty decent shape, and they have being doing patching and catch basins, and a lot of bulk pickups because residents are cleaning their yards.

<u>Supervisor Howard T. Phillips, Jr.</u> wanted to know how the curbs are on Rosman Road.

George Wargo, Superintendent of Highways, stated that he will look at those curbs, and also that Mountainview to Locust are in pretty bad shape and we will put it on for a Capital Project for next year. He also stated that concrete curbs might work better there.

Charles Miller, Chief of Police, stated that along with the Task Force and Crime Unit we had a big drug bust at the Mount Ivy Trailer Park. We were the catalyst to start the investigation. He also stated that we had another arrest in Garnerville, where they found two shot guns and a large quantity of drugs.

Supervisor Howard T. Phillips, Jr. stated that we are waiting on five State grants: for the design of the ball fields at Helen Hayes Hospital property, construction of a dog park on Beach Road, construction of a fishing pier and a \$250,000.00 grant for resurfacing our roads.
