ADOPTION OF MINUTES

ADOPTION OF MINUTES - TOWN BOARD MEETING OF DECEMBER 12, 2016, SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING OF DECEMBER 21, 2016, AND REORGANIZATION MEETING OF JANUARY 5, 2017 as submitted by the Town Clerk and on motion by Councilman Gamboli, seconded by Councilman Cancel, were unanimously adopted.

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION UNDER STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT (SEQRA) FOR PROPOSED RECREATIONAL COMPLEX TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW, NY

Councilman Soto offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Gould, and on roll call unanimously adopted.

- **68-17 WHEREAS**, The Town of Haverstraw proposes to construct a recreational complex (hereafter referred to as, "proposed action") including:
 - Installation a concession and restroom facilities
 - Dog park
 - Football (1), baseball (1) and little league (3) fields.
 - Parking area
 - Bleachers

WHEREAS said proposed action is a Type I Action under 6NYCRR Part 617 because the action impacts greater than 10 acres under 6NYCRR Part 617.4 or 617.5.

WHEREAS, the Town of Haverstraw Board (hereafter, "the Board"), having approval authority over the proposed action, duly declared itself lead agency on October 24, 2016 for a coordinated review among multiple authorizing agencies per 6NYCRR Part 617.6(b)(2)(i), and has received no objection to this declaration from other agencies within 30 days, and

WHEREAS, the Board, as lead agency, must make a determination of significance of the proposed action per 6NYCRR Part 617.4, and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the proposed action as defined in 6NYCRR Part 617.2(b) and 617.3(g), and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed Parts 1, 2, and 3 of a Full Environmental Assessment Form prepared for the proposed action under criteria outlined in 6NYCRR Part 617.7(c), and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the proposed work will not result in significant adverse environmental impacts to:

- Land
- Water
- Air
- Plants and Animals
- Agricultural Resources
- Aesthetic Resource
- Cultural or Archeological Resources
- Open Space
- Critical Environmental Areas
- Transportation
- Energy
- Noise or Odor
- Public Health
- Community Character

And

WHEREAS, the Board finds, based on the criteria outlined in 6NYCRR Part 617.7(c), that the proposed action will <u>not</u> have a significant adverse impact on the environment for the following reasons:

- The proposed action is not located within regulated resources (i.e. state or federally-regulated wetlands.
- The proposed action is not located within a state-regulated viewshed.
- The proposed action will not adversely impact local traffic, public health or community character.

Therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board shall adopt in its determination of significance under 6NYCRR Part 617.7, this *NEGATIVE DECLARATION*, indicating that information provided in the Full Environmental Assessment Form attached hereto has sufficiently demonstrated that the proposed action will not result in significant adverse environmental impacts, and that an Environmental Impact Statement need not be prepared.
