#### PRESENTATION BY GEORGE BEHN, BUILDING INSPECTOR

George Behn, Building Inspector stated that he has received numerous complaints with regard to this property. Mr. Behn presented photographs to the Board showing the condition of the property and as of today the conditions remain the same. The grass and weeds exceed the twelve inch height permitted. Under Section 127-31 of the Town Code, that when there are "Zombie properties" that are in foreclosure or about to be in foreclosure or where there is no longer an interested homeowner living in the house to maintain the outside of the property, and where the grass is overgrown over the allowed height, the Town Board can schedule a Public Hearing to adopt a resolution allowing the Building Inspector to get estimates and hire a private contractor to do the work to maintain the outside of the property. The charges incurred to do the work can then go on to the tax bill of the property.

An Affidavit of Posting and proof that a certified letter was sent to the last known address of the property owner were presented to the Town Clerk.

#### **BOARD MEMBERS**

The Town Board found that the property had overgrown grass and weeds in violation of the Town Code property maintenance provisions and gave the Building Inspector continuing authorization to retain a contractor to cut the grass during the rest of 2018.
