PROCLAMATION DECLARING MAY 2020 AS "MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH" IN THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW

Councilman Gould offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Ortiz, and on roll call unanimously adopted.

210-20 WHEREAS, THE MONTH OF MAY HAS BEEN DESIGNATED AS MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH THROUGHOUT THE NATION SINCE 1949; AND

WHEREAS, ADDRESSING THE COMPLEX MENTAL HEALTH NEEDS OF CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES TODAY IS FUNDAMENTAL TO THE FUTURE OF THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW; AND

WHEREAS, MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS ARE PREVALENT IN OUR NATION AND THAT 1 OUT OF 5 CHILDREN, AGES 13 – 18, HAVE OR WILL HAVE A SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS; AND

WHEREAS, THE NEED FOR COMPREHENSIVE, COORDINATED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, YOUNG ADULTS, AND FAMILIES PLACES A CRITICAL RESPONSIBILITY UPON OUR COMMUNITY; AND

WHEREAS, SUICIDE IS THE 3RD LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN YOUTH AGES 10-24 AND AN ESTIMATED 22 VETERANS DIE FROM SUICIDE EACH DAY; AND

WHEREAS, STIGMA AND FEAR OF DISCRIMINATION KEEP MANY WHO WOULD BENEFIT FROM MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FROM SEEKING HELP; AND

WHEREAS, WITH EFFECTIVE TREATMENT THOSE INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS CAN RECOVER AND LEAD FULL, PRODUCTIVE LIVES; AND

WHEREAS, EDUCATION, COMPASSION, AND AWARENESS ABOUT MENTAL ILLNESS CAN CHANGE NEGATIVE ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIORS TOWARD PEOPLE WITH MENTAL ILLNESS; AND

WHEREAS, EACH BUSINESS, SCHOOL, GOVERNMENT AGENCY, LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, HEALTHCARE PROVIDER, ORGANIZATION AND CITIZEN SHARES THE RESPONSIBILITY TO PROMOTE MENTAL WELLNESS AND SUPPORT PREVENTION EFFORTS; AND

WHEREAS, THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE ON MENTAL ILLNESS OF ROCKLAND COUNTY (NAMI ROCKLAND) IS A GRASSROOTS COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH AGENCY AFFILIATED WITH NAMI-NYS AND NAMI NATIONAL AND DEDICATED TO IMPROVING THE LIVES OF INDIVIDUALS LIVING WITH MENTAL ILLNESS AND THEIR FAMILIES THROUGH EDUCATION, SUPPORT AND ADVOCACY; AND
