2020/21 MUNICIPAL SNOW AND ICE AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT AND ADJUSTMENT/CALCULATION WORKSHEETS

With our Municipal Snow and Ice Agreements now five-year agreements, DOT no longer needs to approve one-year extensions every year. However, we are still required to adjust the estimated expenditure each year of the contract term to account for changes in labor, materials, equipment, and fixed costs. In years 2 through 5 of each contract, the estimate may require a simple re-calculation or a fully approved and executed contract amendment (also known as a Supplemental Agreement) depending on how light or severe the previous winter was.

The materials for the 2020/21 Municipal Snow and Ice Agreement Adjustment/Calculation Worksheets and Supplemental Agreement Cover are being sent with this letter. The package includes the worksheets themselves, and the Supplemental Agreement Cover document.

The Adjustment/Calculation worksheets will contain specific criteria found near the end to determine whether a Supplemental Agreement will be needed, based on how much the 2020/21 estimate changes from last year.

The completed package shall include the items listed below:

If the Supplemental Agreement Cover is required:

- 1. Four (4) Supplemental Agreements, with the appropriate fields filled in with original signatures and notary seal on each.
- 2. Four (4) filled-out and signed Adjustment/Calculation Worksheets.
- Four (4) Resolutions from the Municipality complete with original signatures and certified with Municipal Seal on each.

If the Supplemental Agreement Cover is NOT required:

Three (3) filled-out and signed Adjustment/Calculation Worksheets.

NOTE: if there are other changes that need to be made to the original Agreement, such as a change in lane miles being contracted out, or a change to the map originally provided in the Agreement, or any other changes being made to the terms of the agreement other than revising the estimate, then a completed Supplemental Agreement will be required and need the items listed above.

It is important that the documents be returned to Main Office for processing as soon as possible. Failure to return the completed documents to Main Office by December will result in delays in issuing the correct Interim Payment amount.

Re: Terms and Conditions of Employment – May 24, 2022 to December 31, 2022

Dear Captain John J Gould Jr.:

This letter is written to inform you that, subject to the approval of the Town Board, the following shall constitute the terms and conditions of your employment for the period from May 24, 2022 until December 31, 2022:

1. You shall receive all the benefits contained in the following paragraphs. All provisions of the Town of Haverstraw PBA Contact or any subsequent changes shall not apply to you.

2. <u>Compensation</u>:

Effective May 24, 2022, your annual compensation will be based upon the following:

(a) 2022 Prorated Annual Base Salary

\$ 220,036

(b) 2022 Longevity – Annual longevity shall be \$1,704 per step (each step is after every three years of service not to exceed 8 steps).

3. Work Schedule:

- (a) Your regular work shall be two hundred Sixty (260) days, excluding vacation and other approved leave. Your work schedule will be established by the Chief of Police.
- (b) Your regular work schedule under normal circumstances will not exceed 40 hours per week. You will be and are considered a managerial salaried employee of the Town not subject to hourly rate deductions in pay. As such, you are not entitled to overtime for hours worked in excess of your regular work schedule. Any such hours will be worked without additional compensation.
- (c) You shall attend all regular meetings and special meetings of the Town Board when the Chief is absent. Special meetings shall include, but are not limited to, day or evening meetings, meetings with members of the public, meetings regarding disciplinary actions, procedural or regulatory review, meetings regarding labor complaints, legal actions by the union, labor negotiations, legal actions against or initiated by the Town. Regular Town Board Meetings are the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month and as otherwise established by the Board. You will be notified either orally or in writing, at the discretion of the Town, of all special meetings of the Town Board which require your attendance.
- (d) You shall perform all duties set forth in the civil service job description for the title of Captain as directed by the Chief, Supervisor or Town Board, including but not limited to internal affairs investigations.

4. <u>Vacation/Holiday</u>:

- (a) You shall receive Forty Four (44) days of vacation annually. This time will be taken at the discretion of the Chief of Police. Vacation days may not be carried over in excess of ten (10) unused days from year to year. As such, accrued vacation may not exceed fifty four (54) days.
- (b) You will not receive any holidays off or any holiday pay as compensation, said holidays are already included in your base salary.

5. **Drug Testing**:

You are subject to random drug testing as determined and at the discretion of the Town. The scientific method used to analyze all specimens taken for testing will be consistent with the methods enumerated in the drug testing provisions of the collective bargaining agreement between the Town and the P.B.A. A positive test will result in discipline including dismissal from service. Refusal to be tested will be considered a positive test.

6. **Indemnification**:

The provisions of Section 18 of the Public Officers' Law concerning defense and indemnification will apply to you and the Town hereby confers the benefits of such Section upon you and agrees to be held liable for the costs incurred as a result. However, you must meet the time limits set forth in Section 18 in order to be eligible for the protections provided there under.

7. **Physical Examination**

The Town may, at its discretion, provide you with an annual physical examination by a physician designated by the Town at the Town's expense on or about the anniversary date of your appointment to the position of Captain.

8. Sick Leave/Personal Leave

- (a) In lieu of the sick leave provisions of the Haverstraw PBA Agreement, you shall be entitled to unlimited, fully paid sick leave in the event of illness, injury or other physical disability. Any prior accumulated sick leave shall be replaced by the unlimited sick leave benefit and you do not accumulate any sick leave days per month. The Town may require medical evidence and verification for any such absence. In addition, verification may be conducted by a physician designated by the Town.
- (b) You are permitted to utilize five (5) sick days each year in the event of illness of your spouse, child or parent residing in your household. The Town may request medical documentation to support a family illness.
- (c) You are entitled to six (6) days of personal leave per year on the condition that permission for such leave must be given by the Chief of Police.
- (d) In the event of a death in your immediate family (including mother, father, brother, sister, wife, children, grandmother or grandfather) a leave of up to four (4) days is to be granted dependent on need or distance and within the discretion of the Chief. In the event of the death of your father-in-law, mother-in-law, sister-in-law or brother-in-law, a leave of up to three (3) days is to be granted dependent on need or distance and within the discretion of the Chief.
- 9. No accrued time will be available for any type sellback except for unused vacation, which will be paid out at retirement.

10. **Insurance**

- (a) The Town shall provide at its own expense for the benefit of you and your dependents health insurance, which insurance shall continue in effect after your retirement, including disability retirement, into the State Retirement System from the Haverstraw Police Department. The Town reserves the right, at its discretion, to change health insurance carriers and health insurance benefits. However, the Retiree Benefits will be no less than that provided the PBA.
- (b) The Town shall pay the premium toward dental insurance for you and your dependents and you will contribute \$65 per month towards the monthly premium. The Town reserves the right, at its discretion, to change dental insurance carriers and dental benefits. At retirement your Dental Insurance coverage will be terminated, unless you elect to continue your coverage at your own cost for the total Dental Insurance premium.
- (c) The Town agrees to reimburse you for eye exams, glasses or contact lenses for him and his dependents up to a maximum of \$100 per person per year. Reimbursement shall be made upon presentation of a valid receipt for the service indicated.
- (d) The Town agrees to pay the full cost of a life insurance policy in the face amount of sixty thousand (\$60,000) dollars with double indemnity.

11. Vehicle

The Town Board will provide you, at its discretion, with an unmarked, police equipped vehicle for your use in connection with your duties as a Captain as well as commutation. Said vehicle shall be maintained by the Town of Haverstraw in good appearance and in good working order. The Town Board reserves the right to withdraw this privilege.

12. Uniform

Your uniforms shall be supplied by the Town together with all equipment as issued by the Department. An annual stipend of Six Hundred Five Dollars (\$605.00) will be provided for uniform cleaning and maintenance as long as you are on active duty. This amount will be prorated if you are not on active duty.

13. Major Events Stipend

There are Three (3) Major events in the Town each year, the Gran Fondo, Town of Haverstraw Fireworks and the Latin Day Festival. The Captain will be paid for hours worked outside of his normal work shift on each of these events up to a max of 30 hours at his hourly rate. The stipend event hours must be submitted to payroll for the next pay period following the event.

14. **Term**

These terms shall remain in full force and effect until December 31, 2022. Thereafter, said terms may be changed by the Town Board at its discretion. However, under no circumstances will the salary in a subsequent year be less than the year before unless imposed as the result of discipline following appropriate due process. Any terms not referenced herein may be changed at any time at the discretion of the Town Board.
