**RESOLUTION CALLING ON THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO
OPPOSE THE FAITH-BASED AFFORDABLE HOUSING ACT**

Councilman Kirschkel offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Ortiz, and on roll call unanimously adopted.

241-24 WHEREAS, THE FAITH-BASED AFFORDABLE HOUSING ACT HAS BEEN INTRODUCED IN BOTH THE NEW YORK STATE SENATE (S.7791) AND THE NEW YORK STATE ASSEMBLY (A.8396) IN THE 2023-2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION; AND WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION WOULD ALLOW HOUSES OF WORSHIP TO BUILD HIGH-DENSITY AFFORDABLE HOUSING; AND WHEREAS, ZONING HAS HISTORICALLY BEEN THE PROVINCE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT; AND

WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION VITIATES THE LONGSTANDING PRINCIPLE OF LOCAL CONTROL OVER ZONING AND IMPOSES A ONE-SIZE FITS ALL APPROACH THAT DOES NOT UNIVERSALLY REFLECT THE NEEDS, ECONOMIC REALITIES, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION PRIORITIES OR CONCERNS OF EACH COMMUNITY; AND

WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION WOULD ALLOW THE CONSTRUCTION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING UP TO 35 FEET TALL, WITH 30 UNITS PER ACRE, IN MUNICIPALITIES WITH FEWER THAN 50,000 RESIDENTS AND UP TO 55 FEET TALL, WITH 50 UNITS PER ACRE, IN MUNICIPALITIES WITH MORE THAN 50,000 RESIDENTS; AND

WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION EXPRESSLY PRECLUDES LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FROM IMPOSING COMMONSENSE REQUIREMENTS DESIGNED TO PROTECT THE CHARACTER OF THEIR COMMUNITIES AND THE QUALITY OF LIFE ENJOYED BY LOCAL RESIDENTS AND DESTROYS THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW PROCESS; AND

WHEREAS, THE PLANNING PROCESS MUST BE PREDICATED ON A TRANSPARENT, ACCOUNTABLE AND DEMOCRATIC MECHANISM THROUGH WHICH DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS ARE VETTED AND APPROVED; AND

WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION CIRCUMVENTS THE PLANNING PROCESS AND DISENFRANCHISES THE PUBLIC; AND

WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION DOES NOT TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING THAT MANY COMMUNITIES HAVE ALREADY APPROVED AND CONSTRUCTED; AND

WHEREAS, THIS LEGISLATION FAILS TO GIVE CONSIDERATION TO LOCAL MUNICIPALITIES WHICH HAVE PROVIDED AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR THEIR RESIDENTS; AND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE TOWN OF HAVERSTRAW ENCOURAGES THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE TO ABANDON THE FAITH-BASED AFFORDABLE HOUSING ACT'S FLAWED APPROACH AND WORK WITH ITS PARTNERS IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO DEVELOP A MORE THOUGHTFUL PLAN TO PROMOTE THE ACCESSIBILITY OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING.
