WHAT IS THE 19TH ANNUAL NORTH ROCKLAND COMMUNITY <u>5K RUN/WALK?</u>

It is our good fortune to announce the 19th Annual North Rockland Community 5K Run/Walk. This will be a day of community involvement for a wonderful cause. The community will be donating the proceeds from the 5K Run/Walk to:

JACOB LOPEZ is a 4 year old amazing, smart, and loving boy who resides in West Haverstraw, NY. On November 2023, Jacob had a life changing event; he was diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes. During this time, he was admitted to pediatric intensive care in Maria Ferrari Children's Hospital in Westchester. Type 1 Diabetes is an autoimmune disease in which the pancreas stops making insulin to sustain a normal glucose level. Unfortunately, Jacob now depends on insulin in order to survive. He's had to adapt to this new way of life and had to change his school to one which can monitor his levels and have experts on staff. Jacob's doctors have recommended for him to obtain a service dog that would alert before his glucose goes high or low.

JARIEL SANTIAGO is a senior at North Rockland High School. In 2023, He went to Westchester Medical Center, and it was discovered that he had a germ cell tumor. The tumor markers were extremely high, indicating that the tumor was, unfortunately, cancerous. Jariel's tumor got aggressive and hemorrhaged. He was unresponsive and went into a coma. He was intubated that night at Westchester Medical Center. Before Jariel was able to start his chemotherapy treatment, he underwent surgeries to help drain the blood from his brain. He remained in the hospital for three months before he was able to start an intensive chemotherapy treatment. Following his chemotherapy treatment, Jariel received radiation. In January 2024, Jariel had his first MRI following the treatment and received the news that there was no longer any mark of the tumor in his brain. Between the hospital bills and the treatments, the medical debt has been astronomical. Jariel's mother, Jennifer Rolon, had to drive to the city every day for Jariel's radiation treatments. She had to put many of her bills to the side because she couldn't afford it while doing her best to cover the costs of Jariel's treatments. While she has worked hard to try to pay off the bills, she is still heavily burdened by the medical debt that has accumulated.

The run/walk will take place on Sunday, June 2, 2024, at Bowline Point Park. The Children's Race will begin at 8:30 AM and the 5K Run/Walk will begin at 9:30 AM. Based on previous years, we are anticipating a tremendous turnout from people throughout Rockland County.

The 19th Annual North Rockland Community 5K Run/Walk will be chaired by Town of Haverstraw Supervisor Howard T. Phillips, Jr., Town of Stony Point Supervisor Jim Monaghan and North Rockland Athletic Director Joseph Casarella.

Even in these difficult economic times, the people of North Rockland and Rockland County have always dedicated themselves to helping those in need. We believe that is the true nature and character of our residents and businesses.
